Powered by a Ford 200hp 2728T which has done Approximately 4000 hrs.

Twin disc MG-506 gearbox

Recent engine work carried out by Moon Engines includes- Fuel injectors replaced, fuel pump overhaul, reset timing,

tappets reset, turbo checked, fuel and oil filters changed.

Cruises at 9 knots burning Approximately 14 ltrs per hour.

She holds 1000 ltrs of fuel which allows for extended coastal cruising.

She holds 500ltrs of water.

Electronics include Colour depth sounder/ fishfinder, GPS/chart plotter. VHF, Auto pilot.

Good refrigeration with an engine driven compressor servicing a Fridge and Freezer.

2 x 150W solar panels with a 220ah House battery provides more than enough power supply for the domestic systems.

The very large forward accommodation area sleeps 6. There are 4 generous sized bunks in the forward cabin and a large

double bed in the lower saloon that can fold away to become a couch for day trips.

Hot water is via a hot water cylinder.

Additional steering station on the Flybridge.

Maxwell electric anchor winch.

Maintenance Log and manuals supplied.

A 10ft Pelin plywood dinghy with a new 6hp Parson outboard can be negotiated.

Safety Equipment comprises a VHF, 2 x 2 kg fire extinguishers, and 6 x lifejackets.

Ground tackle is 90 meters of 10mm galvanized chain with Danforth anchor.

This is a very reliable traditional cruising launch with all the home comforts.
